On Sunday, March 2nd, Lydia B. The film features the stories of six modern-day pilgrims who range from 3 to 73 years of age as they walk the historic 500-mile journey along Spain's 1200-year-old Camino de Santiago trail. The film presents universal themes through personal stories for those seeking to redefine the way they live, or deepen their relationship with others, and to rediscover the true meaning of their connection with the world.
